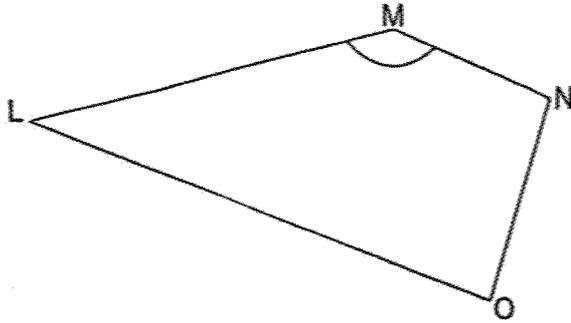

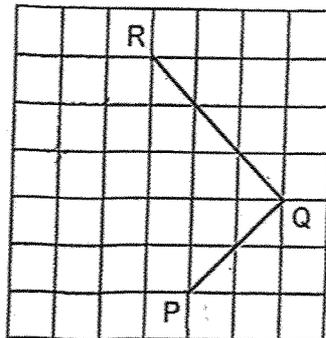

8. The square grid shows side PQ and QR of rectangle PQRS. Complete rectangle PQRS by drawing 2 more lines on the grid. Label the rectangle.



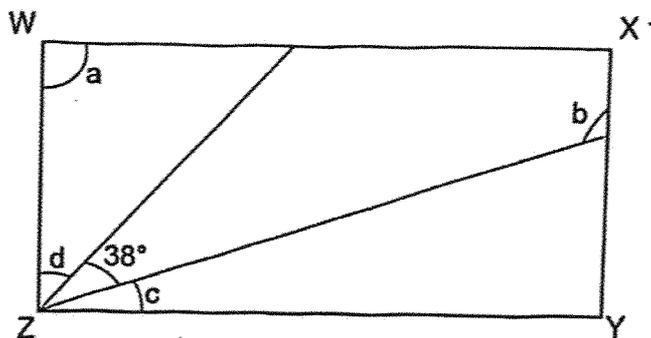

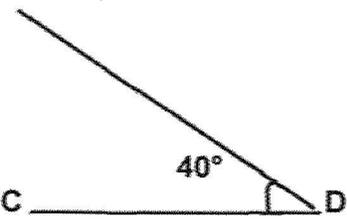
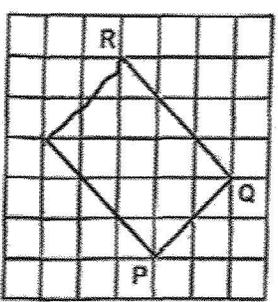
